So we do not contribute to the training of any criminal element, DVC Training Specialists, L.L.C. has a strict credentialing policy. A photocopy of one of the following documents must be attached to this application:

- § Concealed Carry Permit from any State
- § Notarized Statement from Local LE Agency Stating You Have no Criminal History.
- § Active Duty Police Identification or Active Duty Military Identification

The only exception to this requirement is for the Kansas Concealed Handgun License Class. If I cannot meet the above-mentioned credentialing methods, I may be required to fill out a DVC Training Specialists, L.L.C. Certificate of Good Conduct

I agree to abide by the following safety rules during the duration of the class. I also understand that violating any of the safety rules listed below can and will result in my immediate dismissal of the class. Being dismissed as a result of safety violations will result in forfeiture of my class tuition.

1. No firearms are permitted in any training area unless specifically required by the Instructor.
2. No live ammunition shall be permitted in the classroom. No exceptions. This includes instructors and Law Enforcement. This is a safety issue.
3. All firearms will be inspected by an Instructor prior to any class and shall remain unloaded until an Instructor informs the student otherwise.
4. Eye and ear protection will be worn at all times while on the range.
5. Firearms used for training purposes other than qualification on a range shall be unloaded and inspected by the Instructor teaching the class. The chamber(s) will be visually and physically inspected to insure that they are empty. At no time will a real firearm of any type be pointed at another human being. Plastic training guns will be used if there is any chance of this happening during training.
6. Students and Instructors are expressly prohibited from being under the influence, to any extent of alcoholic beverages or drugs of any type.
7. No "horseplay" while on the range or in the classroom.
8. Students will follow all commands given by the Instructor.
9. When on the range, all firearms will be benched or holstered, unless told otherwise by an Instructor.
10. The four rules of gun safety will be strictly adhered to at all times. The four basic rules of gun safety are:
 - I. All firearms are always loaded. Never take the word of someone else. Always check for yourself.
 - II. Always keep your firearm pointed in a safe direction. Never let your muzzle cover anything that you are not willing to destroy.
 - III. Always keep your trigger finger straight along the frame until you are on target and are ready to fire.
 - IV. Always identify your target and what is beyond it. If the projectile over penetrates will it harm an innocent bystander?
11. At the command of cease-fire or similar command, all shooters will immediately stop firing, keep their firearms pointed downrange and listen

for further instructions from the Instructor or Range Safety Officer. Any person on the range may yell cease-fire if they witness an unsafe act.

12. All ammunition utilized on the range will be factory ammunition. We also require brass cased ammunition on our range. Steel cased ammunition is considered a safety concern.

13. Anything that hits the ground is non-retrievable until you are authorized to pick it up by an Instructor or a Range Safety Officer. No brass can be recovered at the conclusion of a class.

I, the undersigned, understand that a 50% non-refundable deposit is required to hold a slot for the class that I have applied for. I understand that this deposit will be refunded if it is deemed that I am ineligible for the class. My deposit will also be refunded if I have to cancel for any reason, on the condition that another student can be found to take my place in the class.

The balance of my tuition will be due at the time of the class, if I am using certified funds. If I will be paying the balance utilizing a personal or business check, DVC Training Specialists, L.L.C. must receive the balance at least 14 days prior to the start of the class.

At the beginning of class during registration, I must present Government issued photo identification to prove my identity. This may be in the form of a Driver's License, State issued identification card, or Military Identification.

I understand that DVC Training Specialists, L.L.C. reserves the absolute right to refuse training for any reason whatsoever to any applicant. Submission of this application indicates my clear understanding of this provision.
